IMSA provides access to computer resources in an effort to facilitate the learning process and to provide high quality outcomes for our students. Do not pass around any equipment.

Parents will be held financially liable for any damage caused to the information technology equipment. Any misuse will force us to exclude students from using the information technology equipment and may result in further disciplinary actions.
